

Pediatric Cardiac Sonographer Lead Echocardiography Technologist Position, Cohen Children's Medical Center of New York

Overview

Northwell Health is recruiting a full time senior pediatric sonographer- lead to join its busy congenital echo lab at the Cohen Children's Medical Center in Long Island, New York . The lead will oversee a group of 19 enthusiastic sonographers in supporting IAC-Accredited Echocardiography Laboratory. The lab provides key support for fetal thru adult congenital cardiology, including the interventional catheterization lab and cardiac OR, as well as the ICU's and ambulatory cardiology clinics. Cohen Children's Medical Center has satellite clinics throughout Brooklyn, Manhattan, Northern Westchester, Queens, Nassau & Suffolk County and receives referrals at the main center in New Hyde Park. The congenital heart program includes 24 cardiologists, 2 cardiothoracic surgeons, and 6 advanced practice providers. The sonographers are an integral part of our highly collaborative team with great opportunities for professional growth and development.

Summary of Responsibilities

- Experience performing echocardiographic studies within the complete spectrum of diagnoses seen in congenital and pediatric heart disease, with minimal supervision.
- Assist cardiologist with the technical components of transesophageal echocardiography or other special procedures/advanced imaging techniques.
- Performs advanced imaging including strain, 3D, and stress echo if possible.
- Demonstrates the clinical judgment to recognize and triage an emergent situation appropriately, such as calling immediate review before study completion.
- Performing transthoracic & fetal echocardiograms 50% of the time.
- Demonstrates competency with all aspects of the ultrasound equipment, and able to supervise regular maintenance and equipment upgrade/replacement needs.
- Provides leadership in sonographer scheduling, call rotation, and lab maintenance job duties involving Syngo Reading Stations & maintenance of volumes.
- Supervises and teaches other sonographers and pediatric cardiology fellows.
- Participates in lab teaching, operational and quality assurance meetings.
- Participates in ongoing clinical research, national conferences and IAC meetings.
- Assists medical director in maintaining labs ICAEL certification in transthoracic, transesophageal, and fetal echocardiography.
